Eligibility: “A three-year degree with honours (50% of marks) and general stream (55% of marks) in subject concerned. Relaxation of 5% for SC/ST candidates is admissible.

M.Phil: (Subject to availability of seats of vacancies in the respective departments)

Eligibility:

The candidates with at-least 55% marks (50% in the case of candidates belonging to SC/ST) in the Master degree in the subject concerned will be required to appear for an entrance test followed by viva-voce to be conducted by the respective departments.

Ph.D: (Subject to availability of seats of vacancies in the respective departments)

Eligibility: The candidate/s with at least 55% (50% in the case of candidates belonging to SC/ST) marks in the Master’s Degree in the subject concerned will be required to appear in a written test and/or an interview to be conducted by the Department.

Note: For M.Phil/Ph.D admission, selection shall be made in accordance with the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for awards of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree), Regulation, 2009 and Ordinance of the Nagaland University.

10 + 2 Science with Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics/Biology with 50% marks in aggregate and 5% relaxable in case of SC/ST candidates.

Eligibility:

B.Sc (Ag.) with O.G.P.A. 6.5 for General and 6.0 for SC/ST candidates in 10- Point-Grading.

Ph.D (SASRD), Medzhiphema - (Subject to availability of seats of vacancies in the respective departments)

Eligibility:

The candidates with at-least 55% marks (50% in the case of candidates belonging to SC/ST) in their Master degree in the subject concerned will be required to appear for an entrance test followed by viva-voce to be conducted by the respective departments.

Note: For M.Phil/Ph.D admission, selection shall be made in accordance with the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for awards of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree), Regulation, 2009, ICAR and Ordinance of the Nagaland University.

Allocation of seats for B.Sc (Ag.) to N.E. states, Nagaland state & VC's quota shall be made as per the Govt./University rules.

Requisition letter may be addressed to the Deputy Registrar (Academic), Nagaland University, Lumami – 798 627 along with a bank draft drawn in favour of Registrar, Nagaland University, Lumami, payable at SBI, NU, Lumami or I.P.O. in favour of Registrar, Nagaland University, Lumami payable at BPO, NU, Lumami. The candidates desirous to obtain the prospectus

by post must enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope of Rs.30/- affixed therein for the purpose.
